Social Emotional Learning Coach: All Grade Levels

Steamboat Montessori is a public charter school currently in our fifth year serving students and their families. All employees of Steamboat Montessori work together to achieve our school's mission and vision. We seek teachers who are collaborative with colleagues, empathetic in their relationships with students and families, and willing to work above and beyond their job description in order to ensure success for all students. Teachers possess a school-wide focus and draw upon the relationships in their classrooms and the school in order to create a unified community.

Job Description

The Social Emotional Learning Coach will work to build and deepen a positive school climate and culture supporting students to understand and manage emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions. The SEL Coach will center their work on the five core competencies: Self-Awareness, Self Management, Social Awareness, Relationships Skills, and Responsible Decision making in addition to Montessori's Peace Curriculum and Positive Discipline principles. The SEL Coach will be responsible for the direct support to school staff on SEL programming and daily student support.

- Teach SEL competencies to students.
- Support administrators, teachers and other school staff in identifying root causes of student behavioral issues and ways to meet students social and emotional needs.
- Assist and coach students within a consultation framework to increase social/emotional skills.
- Work with administration in implementing all policies and/or rules guiding student behavior and conduct for the classroom.
- Support staff in developing referral, assessment, and progress monitoring systems to coordinate SEL supports.
- Support school in developing community partnerships and linkages for social services and behavioral health supports for high risk students.
- Assist the administration in crisis intervention and emergency response teams.
- Display ethical and professional behavior in working with students, parents, school personnel, and outside agencies associated with the school.
- Perform other duties and responsibilities as directed by the Head of School.

- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Previous teaching experience for elementary school students

- Ability to work collaboratively with students, parents, and other professionals
- Strong self-starter; able to work with limited direction
