SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING TEACHER JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Social Emotional Learning Teacher will work with the Behavioral Health team to build and deepen a positive school climate and culture supporting students to understand and manage emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions. The SEL Coach will center their work on five core competencies: Self-Awareness, Self Management, Social Awareness, Relationships Skills, and Responsible Decision Making in addition to Montessori's Peace Curriculum and Positive Discipline principles. The SEL Coach will be responsible for the direct support to school staff on SEL programming and daily student support.

- Identify and teach SEL competencies to Tier I and II students in a variety of ways.
- Support administrators, teachers and other school staff in identifying root causes of student behavioral issues and design policy and programming to meet students social and emotional needs.
- Work with administration in implementing all policies and/or rules guiding student behavior and conduct for the classroom.
- Support staff in developing referral, assessment, and progress monitoring systems to coordinate SEL supports.
- Display ethical and professional behavior when working with students, parents, and school personnel
- Perform other duties and responsibilities as directed by the Head of School.
